



The Jonesboro Economical Transit System

JETS Fare Policy

- Δ All fares are based on the price of a one-way trip.
- Δ All JETS Passengers must have a destination.
- Δ Paying the fare entitles the passenger to:
 - Ride up the one-hour loop on that Route
 - Transfer to another JETS Fixed Route bus for passage to his/her destination.
- Δ A passenger wishing to remain on the bus past the stop where he/she originally boarded must pay an additional one-way fare.
- Δ If a passenger qualifies for a discounted fare (Senior Adult, ADA Disability, or Student), he/she must request the special fare and present appropriate documentation when boarding.
- Δ All fares should be paid with correct change or a pre-paid JETS pass. JETS drivers can only present a “change card” for credit if overpayment occurs.

Discounted Student (Any Age)	-	\$0.90
Discounted Summer Youth (ages 12-18)	-	\$0.25
Children ages 5 and Younger	-	Free

Unlimited Ride Passes

31 Day Regular Adult Pass	-	\$31.25
31 Day Discounted (Senior Citizen, ADA, or Student)	-	\$20.00
7 Day Regular Adult Pass	-	\$15.00
7 Day Discounted (Senior Citizen, ADA, or Student)	-	\$10.00
1 Day Regular Adult Pass	-	\$ 3.25
1 Day Discounted (Senior Citizen, ADA, or Student)	-	\$ 2.50
Summer Youth Discounted Pass	-	\$20.00

JETS Paratransit Fares

ADA Cash Fares – One-Way

Adult Fare in Target Zone – Up to 3/4 Mile From Fixed Route	-	\$2.50
Adult Fare <3/4 Mile But > 1 ½ Mile From Fixed Route	-	\$5.00
Adult Fare <1 1/2 Mile From Fixed Route But Inside COJ	-	\$7.50

Value Passes

\$10 Value Pass	-	\$10.00
\$20 Value Pass	-	\$20.00

Non-ADA Paratransit Fares (When Available) Are Twice the Comparable ADA Fare
